- 4.1. Members will be aware that Overview and Scrutiny Committees hold agenda planning meetings on a regular basis. ### 6. Committee Development

- 6.1. The Committee has been keen to undertake some additional development opportunities and have undertaken a recent visit to the new Ambulance hub in Gillingham as well as receiving a briefing from Corporate Finance on the budget setting process for 2024/25, with particular focus on the pressures relating to adult social care.
- 6.2. Further briefings in 2025 are to be provided on other aspects of adult social care and, in addition, the Integrated Care Board have offered to host a visit to the Lordswood Healthy Living Centre to look at primary care there. As referenced previously, development sessions with the Committee and the ICB will be set up, part of which will include exploring the development of a Memorandum of Understanding between the Council, Kent County Council and the ICB in relation to health scrutiny. Democratic Services will therefore be canvassing Committee members for a number of dates in the near future.
