

DEVOLUTION DEAL EOI

Preferred geography (upper-tier local authorities in the area)	The preferred geography for a devolution deal is Kent and Medway, comprising the area covered by Kent County Council and Medway Council. There is agreement between all tiers of local government within the Kent region that the Kent and Medway geography is the most appropriate footprint for a devolution deal, but that any deal must be inclusive of our District, City and Borough Councils.
Initial preference on mayoral / non-mayoral devolution	There is no consensus in the region on a mayoral or non-mayoral devolution deal. There is broad agreement across all tiers of local government that we should remain open to discussions on a mayoral devolution model, but this is fully dependent on scale of the 'mayoral premium' to be outlined in the forthcoming Devolution Framework and English Devolution Bill.
