Broadside Office Lease Renewal

Delegation from Cabinet 30 July 2024

The Cabinet agreed to delegate authority to the Director of Place, in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Business Management, to sign and execute a new lease on the best terms reasonably obtainable as set out in the Exempt Appendix to the report ([Decision No. 122/2024](#)). Decision

In accordance with the Cabinet decision, it was decided to renew the lease to the current tenant on the terms set out in the Cabinet paper and exempt annex.

Reasons for Decision

To secure suitable accommodation for Childrens Services at a reduced cost with flexibility to terminate the lease during the term of the lease.
