Safer, Healthier Streets Programme - Provision of Tranche 2 Schools TRO Results of Consultation and Recommendations

Delegation from Cabinet 19 November 2024

On 19 November 2024, the Cabinet agreed to delegate authority to the Director of Place, in consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Community Safety, Highways and Enforcement to consider the outcome of the statutory process (where necessary any amendments) and to take forward necessary infrastructure work and implementation (subject to the statutory process) (Decision No. 144/2024). The Director of Place has, following consultation with the Portfolio Holder for Community Safety, Highways and Enforcement

- Noted and considered the objections received to the proposed traffic order and associated officers' response as summarised in section 4 of the attached report.
- Agreed to make the traffic order which give permanent effect to the following school streets under the provisions of section 124, Schedule 1 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England and Wales) Regulations 1996 regulations 23 and 24:
 - Crest Infants School and Delce Academy, Rochester
 - Horsted Primary School, Chatham
- Noted that a further statutory consultation on The Kings Pre-Preparatory School and Nursery, Rochester with changes made to the design as outlined in section 7 Conclusion of the attached report is required.
