Property Review and Future Management of Heritage Sites

Delegation from Cabinet 13 January 2026

On 13 January 2026 the Cabinet agreed to delegate authority to the Director of Place to make the necessary arrangements to hand back Upnor Castle and Temple Manor to English Heritage, including terminating the Local Management Agreement in respect of the two assets, so that English Heritage took on the full management (Decision No. 11/2026). Decision

On 19 May 2026, Upnor Castle and Temple Manor were handed back to English Heritage, the Local Management Agreement in respect of the two assets was terminated, so that English Heritage took on the full management.

Reasons for Decision

To reduce running costs, to generate a capital receipt, to bring Temple Manor into more intensive use and to hand back Upnor Castle to English Heritage, which is better placed to manage this property.
